PAN-AMERICAN UNDER 20

The Administrative Body of the Colombian Chess Federation, in use of its legal and statutory faculties, and

CONSIDERING:

That, according to the CCA calendar, it is up to the Colombian Chess Federation to hold the Under 20 Pan-American Championship, to be held in the city of Pereira from August 22 to 28, 2022.

DETERMINES:

I. INVITATION

The Colombian Chess Federation and the Chess Confederation of the Americas (CCA) are pleased to invite all the Federations of America, to the Pan-American Under 20, which will be held in the city of Pereira - Risaralda (Colombia) from August 22 to 28, 2022, at the GRAN HOTEL Street 19 # 9 – 19 Pereira.

II. GENERAL RULES

The Pan-American Under 20 will be held according to the FIDE Chess laws and to the regulations for regional youth events of the Chess Confederation for the Americas. Moreover, it will have the following general conditions:

III. FEMALES AND MALES CATEGORIES

Two tournaments will be played, an males' tournament and female's tournament. If in any of the tournaments there are insufficient participants, the organization can unite the tournaments to meet the pairing requirements.

UNDER 20: BORN AFTER JANUARY 1, 2002.

Only Federations affiliated to FIDE-CCA can participate. All participants must be registered by their respective Federation.

Each National Chess Federation may register any number of players, subject to payment of the registration fee, accommodation, food and transportation, for which they or their Federation will be held responsible.

IV. PLAYING SYSTEM

It will be played in a nine (9) round Swiss System or Round Robin depending on the number of players and at the discretion of the head referee.

The pace of play will be ninety (90) minutes for the entire game, plus a thirty (30) second increment per move from the initial move. The tournaments will be valid for International Titles and the FIDE rating. According to what is established in the FIDE regulations

1.1. The Under 20 Pan-American Championship, will be organized by the Colombian Chess Federation – FECODAZ, and will be played from August 22 to 28, 2022, at the GRAN HOTEL in Pereira Calle 19 # 9 - 19.

V. TIEBREAKERS

The final classification will be decided by the points obtained by each player. The player with the highest number of points will be declared the champion. In case of a tie, the winners will be decided by the application of the following Tiebreaker systems in the order mentioned:

In case of a Swiss system tournament:

1. Direct Match (Only if the players involved played each other)

- 2. Greater number of victories (including absences).
- 3. Greater number of games played with the black pieces (unplayed games will count as played with white pieces).
- 4. Bucholz Court 1.
- 5. Bucholz.
- 6. Sonneborn-Berger.
- 7. Younger.

In the case of a Round Robin tournament:

- 1. Direct Match (Only if the players involved played each other)
- 2. Greater number of victories (including absences).
- 3. Sonnenberger
- 4.Koya System

VI. PAIRINGS AND RESULTS

Before the start of the first round of the Championship, a list with all the names of the participants will be published in the game room. The pairings will be published at least one hour after the last game of each round on the official website of the tournament and/or on www.chess-results.com and in the competition hall.

VII. DISCIPLINE

The organizers of the Pan-American Under 20 expect the participants to display the highest standards of behavior and sportsmanship. Tolerance for the forfeit (W.O): Thirty (30) minutes.

VIII. AWARDS

INDIVIDUAL MALE:

Gold: First place

SOLVER: Second placeBRONCE: Third place

INDIVIDUAL FEMALE:

Gold: First place

SOLVER: Second placeBRONCE: Third place

RIGHTS: The winners of the championships have the personal right to participate in the next Pan-American Under 20, if they meet the requirements of ARTICLE III.

XI. OFFICIAL PLAYER RIGHTS

The organization will cover 60% of the lodging and food costs (during the days of August 22 to 29) of the official players by category and sex, of each Federation, according to the financial regulations of the CCA. For registration purposes, these participants will be called Official Players. The rest of the players will have to cover the total costs for lodging and food in the official hotel and will receive the name of extra participants.

XII. REGISTRATION DEADLINE

OFFIAL PLAYERS: Official players will be able to **register until July 20**, 2022, by depositing the corresponding payment. After that period, they may register with **a surcharge of USD\$50.00** for late registration and subject to availability at the official hotel.

ADDITIONAL PLAYERS ANC COMPANION: They can register until July 30, 2022, depositing the corresponding payment. After that period, they may register with a surcharge of USD\$50.00 for late registration and subject to availability at the official hotel.

Each Federation must formalize the registration of its participants. They must authorize and will be responsible for athletes and companions, officials and extras, according to FIDE and CCA regulations. No person may be registered without the approval of their own Federation.

Official Players: The Organization will cover 60% of the accommodation and food expenses of official players (from the night of August 22 to 29) if they confirm their participation by making a registration payment **before July 20**.
